




SUGAR SHACK DINNER

AMISH COUNTRY WASHINGTON, D.C.

The tour leaves York and travels through the fertile farmlands and industrial communities of south central Pennsylvania. 300 Years ago, members of religious groups persecuted in Europe settled here to lead a life focused on religion and farming; today, these people are collectively known as the Pennsylvania Dutch. Visit an Amish Museum (admission included) in Lancaster County, the center of a plain, centuries-old way of life. Head south crossing the state of Maryland, then continue to America's capital, Washington, in the District of Columbia. In the first years of the republic, it was agreed that a capital city should be built halfway between the northern and the southern states. George Washington, the first American president, commissioned his friend Pierre L' Enfant to plan a city worthy of the new nation's capital. Decades after the city was founded, the beauty of L'Enfant's planning became apparent, allowing the city's structure to gradually develop and grow to its present size.




WASHINGTON DC EVENING TOUR WITH DINNER

George Washington, commander in chief of American forces in the Revolutionary War and the first president of the United States, called Mount Vernon home for more than 40 years. George Washington and his wife Martha Washington lived at Mount Vernon, which is now the most popular historic estate in America. Situated along the Potomac River in Northern Virginia, Mount Vernon is just 16 miles south of Washington, D.C.

Today, quests to Mount Vernon can visit the Mansion, more than a dozen original structures, Washington's Tomb, and nearly 50 acres of his extensive plantation. The estate also includes a working blacksmith shop and the Pioneer Farm, a 4-acre demonstration farm with a reconstructed slave cabin and 16-sided treading barn.


The Ford Orientation Center features an inspiring film, We Fight To Be Free. The Donald W. Reynolds Museum and Education Center is home to 25 theaters and galleries, which tell the detailed story of George Washington's life with more than 500 original artifacts. 11 video presentations, and even an immersion theater experience.


Just 3 miles down the road from the Mansion, George Washington's Distillery & Gristmill have been reconstructed and are open seasonally. Both fully functioning, Washington's fascinating mill and distillery tell their story of Washington as a master entrepreneur.

Mount Vernon is an American landmark and a lasting reminder of the life and legacy of the Father of Our Country. Visit Mount Vernon, and discover the real George Washington.




GRACELAND EXPERIENCE






NEW ORLEANS DINNER CRUISE

NEW ORLEANS GULF OF MEXICO PENSACOLA

Leave New Orleans, and head east through Mississippi and into Alabama. Shortly after entering Alabama, you will visit Bellingrath Home and Gardens. This 65-acre estate is known for its beautiful home and prize winning rose gardens. Continue through Mobile. Founded in 1702, Mobile rapidly became one of the most important ports along the Gulf Coast. It played a crucial role for the Confederacy during the Civil War. A month's long battle over Mobile ended with the city's surrender to the Union on April 12, 1865. Continue on to Pensacola, one of Florida's most important vacation destinations. Spanish colonists founded Pensacola in 1599, and they created the first European settlement here. Today, the area is known for its miles of Gulf shoreline, many which are preserved as state and federal parks. Enjoy an afternoon at the beach in Pensacola Beach after which we will continue to our hotel in Pensacola.


