Indian Adventure and Skywalk

"My vision was to enable visitors to walk the path of the eagle..." stated David Jin, the creator of the Grand Canyon Skywalk. Commissioned by the Hualapai Indian tribe, the Skywalk is a U-shaped cantilevered glass bridge that protrudes 70 feet/21 meters beyond the rim of the Grand Canyon, giving visitors a view of the 4,000 feet/1219 meters drop to the Colorado River on the Canyon floor. Opened to the general public since March 28, 2007, this unique design provides an unprecedented and exhilarating view of one of the seven natural wonders of the world. The Skywalk allows visitors to walk out and into the Canyon, peering through the glass floor down at the Canyon or over the glass walls into the valley beyond. Begin your journey with an aerial sightseeing tour to Grand Canyon West and the Hualapai Indian Lands. Enjoy a rustic ground excursion of the Hualapai lands, a light meal right at the edge of the canyon and the amazing Skywalk, before a return flight.

Grand Voyager Flight

Fixed-wing charter aircraft flight, boat excursion and helicopter flight. Experience the Grand Canyon by airplane, boat and helicopter! Start with a fabulous aerial sightseeing tour of Lake Mead, Hoover Dam and the west rim of the Canyon before landing at Grand Canyon West. Descend 4,000 feet from the top of the Canyon to the floor by helicopter. A fabulous boat excursion on the Colorado River explores the beauty and majesty of the Canyon. Return to the top of the rim by helicopter. Visit with native Hualapai Indians during a short, narrated motor coach tour. A light meal is included. Fly back by fixed-wing charter aircraft.

Morning Cowboy Trail Ride

San Francisco Bay Cruise

Get onboard of San Francisco's most popular bay cruise. Onboard this 1-hour cruise, sail past the San Francisco skyline and view the lively neighborhood of North Beach, the famous swimming clubs of Aquatic Park, the historic vessels at Hyde Street Pier, the San Francisco Maritime National Park, and numerous other exciting sights. As you head west towards the Golden Gate Bridge, cruise along Fort Mason and the Marina District, which was devastated in the 1989 earthquake. Don't miss incredible photo opportunities when sailing directly under the massive 4,200-foot (1280 meter) span of the 746-foot (227 meter) tall Golden Gate Bridge. As you steam back into the Bay, travel past Angel Island State Park and slowly cruise around the infamous Island of Alcatraz. On your way back to Fisherman's Wharf, see the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, and Coit Tower.

Golden Gate Walk and Sausalito

This morning join your tour director on a narrated walk across the Golden Gate Bridge into Sausalito followed by a ferry transfer back to San Francisco's Fisherman's Wharf. The iconic bridge was opened to pedestrian traffic in 1937. About 40 million crossings per year are recorded today, counting both north- and southbound directions. Enjoy some time in Sausalito with its historic downtown, once gateway for rum-runners during the Prohibition, and now home to a small artist community.

Return to Fisherman's Wharf via ferry transfer, leaving you time to relaxing in the afternoon, join a bay cruise or bike ride, or discover the city on your own. Tour lasts approximately 4 hours.
