New York Local Attractions

For your free time in New York, may we suggest the following activities:

Manhattan Helicopter

See the United States' most famous landmark the Statue of Liberty- so close you can almost reach out and touch her! Your flight continues as you pass the Empire State Building, Chrysler, Woolworth, and Met Life (Pan Am) Buildings. On the return enjoy views of Ellis Island along with the New York Harbor, George Washington Bridge, and the world renowned Central Park.

Circle Line 2 hour Harbor Cruise

The skyline is breathtaking (weather permitting) and to see the island from the river side something we don't forget. Ask your tour director for more details.

Washington DC Night Tour and Dinner

Tonight, join your tour mates on a memorable evening tour of the Nations Capitol. The monuments by night are a sight to see. In addition, enjoy a delicious dinner in one of Georgetown's favorite restaurants. (There will be no stops during the night tour)

Niagara Falls by Day

Two spectacular views of the falls await you. Visit the Skylon Tower where you will be able to observe the falls from an elevation of 775 feet/236 m. You will lunch in the revolving dining room to experience the panoramic view as you enjoy a tasty menu offering a choice of entrées. After lunch, board the "Maid of the Mist." This boat passes so close to the falls that you almost will be able to touch the thundering water. There is no better way to experience the awesome power of Niagara! The combination of the "Maid of the Mist" and the Skylon Tower luncheon is a perfect way to enjoy an afternoon at the falls.

Niagara Helicopter Tour (8 – 10 minute flight)

View the falls by taking a thrilling helicopter ride over Niagara. Whirl high above the Niagara River, traverse the rapids and the American Falls, then loop over the Horseshoe Falls before returning to the landing pad. This is one of the most exciting ways to view magnificent Niagara Falls.

Willis Tower

Join the approximately 1.5 million tourists who visit the Skydeck each year. You will have the best view over Chicago. At 1,353 feet (412 meters), the Skydeck is the highest observatory in Chicago. The view is amazing! You can see 40 – 50 miles (65 - 80 kilometers) on a clear day. Imagine seeing Michigan, Indiana, Illinois and Wisconsin, just by walking around the Skydeck. And there is no finer view of Chicago architecture from above.

National Parks Air Triangle

Monument Valley with all its amazing mesa's has been immortalized by the western movies of John Ford with John Wayne. Tour this great valley by bus with a Navajo guide and take in this wonderful landscape. From Monument Valley you will continue your flight over the Colorado River and eastern portions of the magnificent Grand Canyon.

San Francisco Bay Cruise

Don't miss incredible photo opportunities when sailing directly under** the massive 4,200-foot (1280 meter) span of the 746-foot (227 meter) tall Golden Gate Bridge. As you steam back into the Bay, travel past Angel Island State Park and slowly cruise around the infamous Island of Alcatraz. On your way back to Fisherman's Wharf, see the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, and Coit Tower.
