### *New York City Attractions*

*For your free time in New York, may we suggest the following activities:*

#### *Manhattan Helicopter*

*See the United States' most famous landmark the Statue of Liberty- so close you can almost reach out and touch her! Your flight continues as you pass the Empire State Building, Chrysler, Woolworth, and Met Life (Pan Am) Buildings. On the return enjoy views of Ellis Island along with the New York Harbor, George Washington Bridge, and the world renowned Central Park.*

*A rendez-vous with tradition "Le Chemin du Roy" maple grove takes its name from the ancestral road that runs through it. The antique style establishment is located close to the Saint Lawrence River, on grounds richly laden with impressive history. Treat yourself to a typical Québécois sugar camp meal to the tune of traditional and folk musical entertainment. Visit the homestead-type maple grove and have the opportunity to buy maple products made on the premises.*

## Day 04 | Montreal – Ottawa – Toronto

## Day 05 | Toronto – Niagara Falls

### CN Tower

The CN Tower is the tallest freestanding structure of North America at a height of 553.33m (1,815 ft., 5 inches). Defining the Toronto skyline, the CN Tower is Canada's most recognizable and celebrated icon. Be amazed by the beautiful views from this tower and may be you dear to risk standing on the glass floor located at 1,122 ft or 342 meters above the ground!

### Niagara Falls by Day

Two spectacular views of the falls await you. Visit the Skylon Tower where you will be able to observe the falls from an elevation of 775 feet/236 m. You will lunch in the revolving dining room to experience the panoramic view as you enjoy a tasty menu offering a choice of entrées. After lunch, board the "Maid of the Mist." This boat passes so close to the falls that you almost will be able to touch the thundering water. There is no better way to experience the awesome power of Niagara! The combination of the "Maid of the Mist" and the Skylon Tower luncheon is a perfect way to enjoy an afternoon at the falls.

### Niagara Helicopter Tour (8-10 minute flight)

View the falls by taking a thrilling helicopter ride over Niagara. Whirl high above the Niagara River, traverse the rapids and the American Falls, then loop over the Horseshoe Falls before returning to the landing pad. This is one of the most exciting ways to view magnificent Niagara Falls.
