San Francisco Bay Cruise

Get onboard of San Francisco's most popular bay cruise. Onboard this 1-hour cruise, sail past the San Francisco skyline and view the lively neighborhood of North Beach, the famous swimming clubs of Aquatic Park, the historic vessels at Hyde Street Pier, the San Francisco Maritime National Park, and numerous other exciting sights. As you head west towards the Golden Gate Bridge, cruise along Fort Mason and the Marina District, which was devastated in the 1989 earthquake. Don't miss incredible photo opportunities when sailing directly under the massive 4,200-foot (1280 meter) span of the 746-foot (227 meter) tall Golden Gate Bridge. As you steam back into the Bay, travel past Angel Island State Park and slowly cruise around the infamous Island of Alcatraz. On your way back to Fisherman's Wharf, see the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, and Coit Tower.

San Francisco Night tou with Dinner

Tonight, join your fellow passengers for an evening out in San Francisco. Start off your evening with an exiting cable car ride over Nob Hill. Next, take a stroll through China Town, which you will surely enjoy. After dinner at Hunan Homes, continue on to Treasure Island, where you will experience a captivating panoramic view of the San Francisco skyline (weather permitting) and slowly drive back to your hotel.

Golden Gate Walk and Sausalito

Join your tour director on a walk across the Golden Gate Bridge into Sausalito followed by a ferry transfer back to San Francisco's Fisherman's Wharf. The iconic bridge was opened to pedestrian traffic in 1937. About 40 million crossings per year are recorded today, counting both north- and southbound directions. Enjoy some time in Sausalito with its historic downtown, once gateway for rum-runners during the Prohibition, and now home to a small artist community. Return to Fisherman's Wharf via ferry transfer, leaving you time to relaxing in the afternoon, join a bay cruise or bike ride, or discover the city on your own. Tour lasts approximately 4 hours.

Double Decker City Tour with Alcatraz

Enjoy a full tour of Alcatraz Island with the award winning cell block audio tour PLUS a fully narrated city tour! With this Hop on Hop off tour you will have 25 stops where you may get off and enjoy the city at your leisure, then jump back on the Double Decker for your next great adventure! One pass is valid for 48 hours, allowing you to enjoy this beautiful city in the sunny daylight hours or at night when your Double Decker grants you a splendid city light view.

Skywalk experience

"My vision was to enable visitors to walk the path of the eagle..." stated David Jin, the creator of the Grand Canyon Skywalk. Commissioned by the Hualapai Indian tribe, the Skywalk is a U-shaped cantilevered glass bridge that protrudes 70 feet/21 meters beyond the rim of the Grand Canyon, giving visitors a view of the 4,000 feet/1219 meters drop to the Colorado River on the Canyon floor. Opened to the general public since March 28, 2007, this unique design provides an unprecedented and exhilarating view of one of the seven natural wonders of the world. The Skywalk allows visitors to walk out and into the Canyon, peering through the glass floor down at the Canyon or over the glass walls into the valley beyond.

Over the Edge: Helicopter and Colorado River boat ride

Look at the Canyon from an eagle eye and fly as an eagle through the Canyon as you decent towards the Colorado River. Upon arrival you will board a pontoon boat and explore the canyon from the bottom. The boat ride is about 15 min. When you return the Helicopter will take you back to the top to complete the all-round Grand Canyon West experience.

Day Trip to Zion National Park
